Programme's priorities and directions of support

Priority 1:

Transport, IT, environment, public services

Priority 2:

Entrepreneurship development, tourism, training and practical education

Priority 3:

Grass-root and community level cooperation

Conditions for applying

- Public sector, NGOs, private companies (Programme financing 50-85% of the project budget)
- Programme financing for one project: €20 000 – €2 000 000
- Project duration – up to 2 years
- Long-term thoroughly planned cooperation vs. one time events
- Joint vs. parallel activities



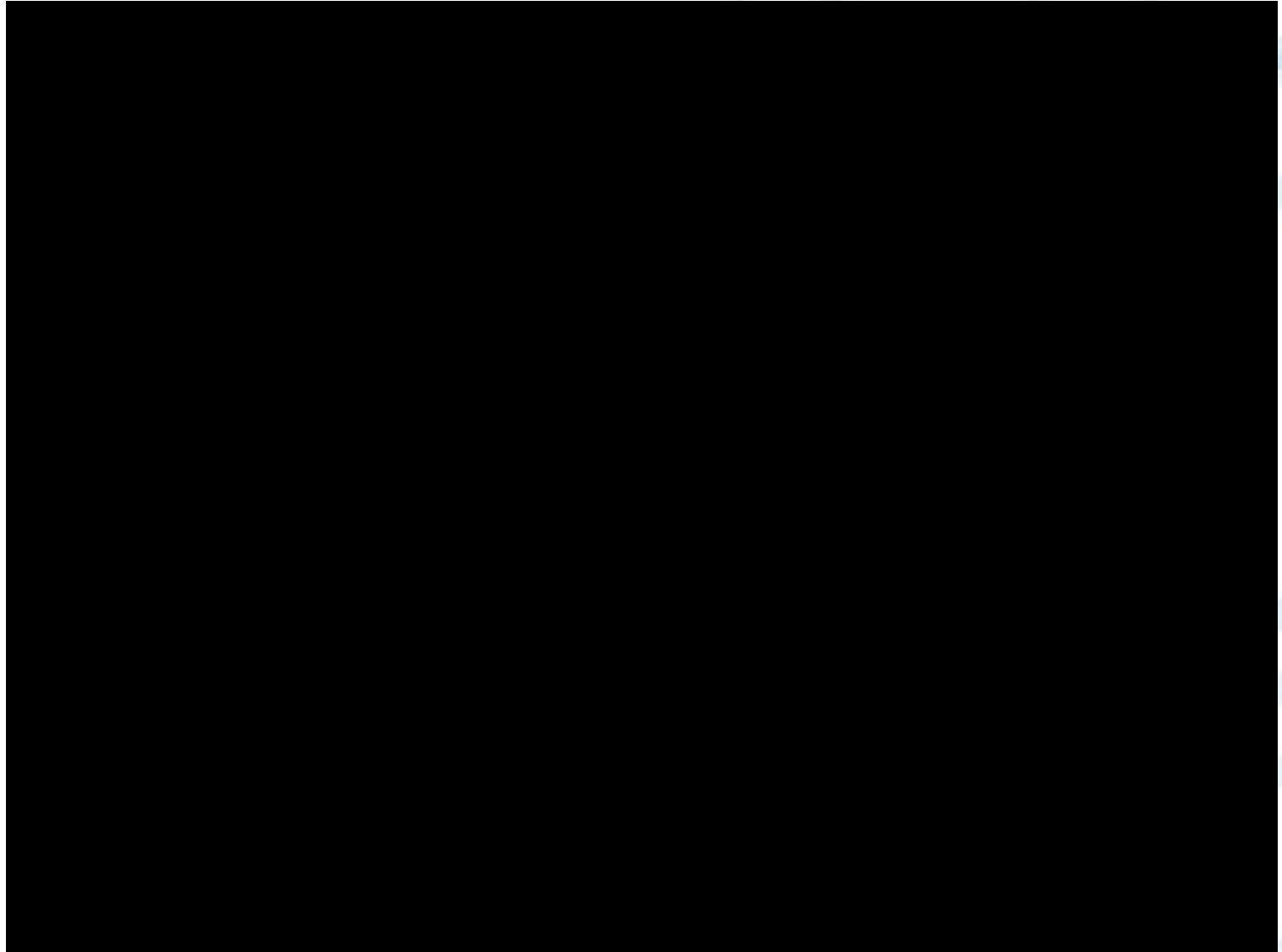

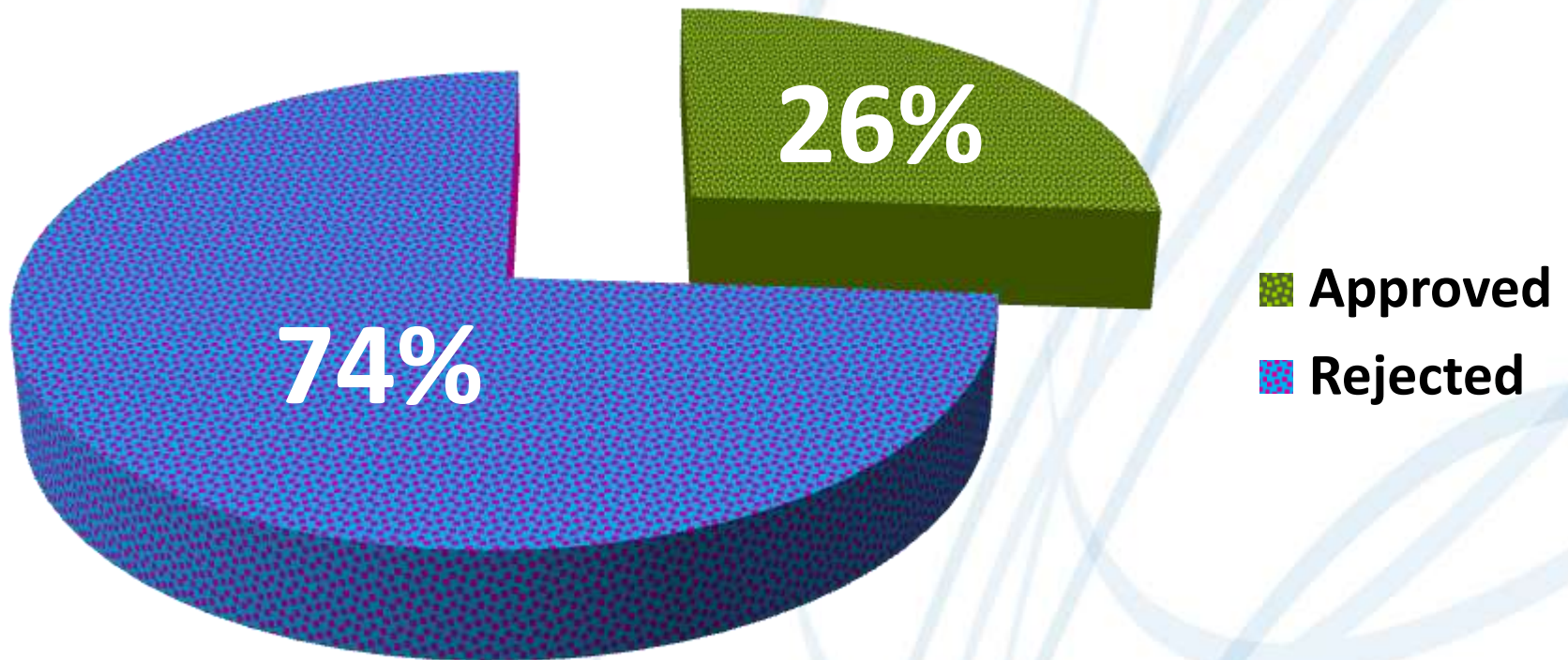
Programme in numbers

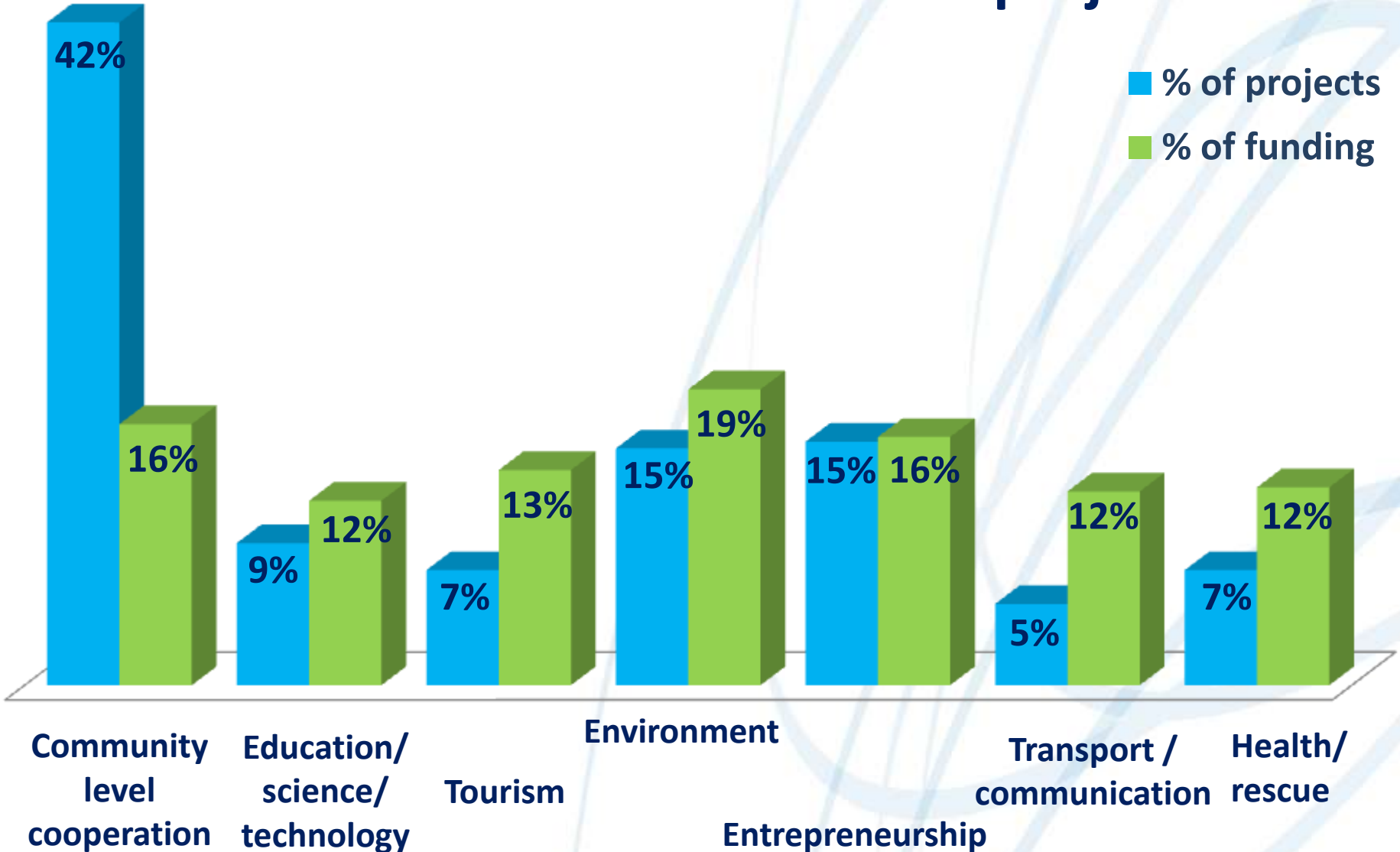

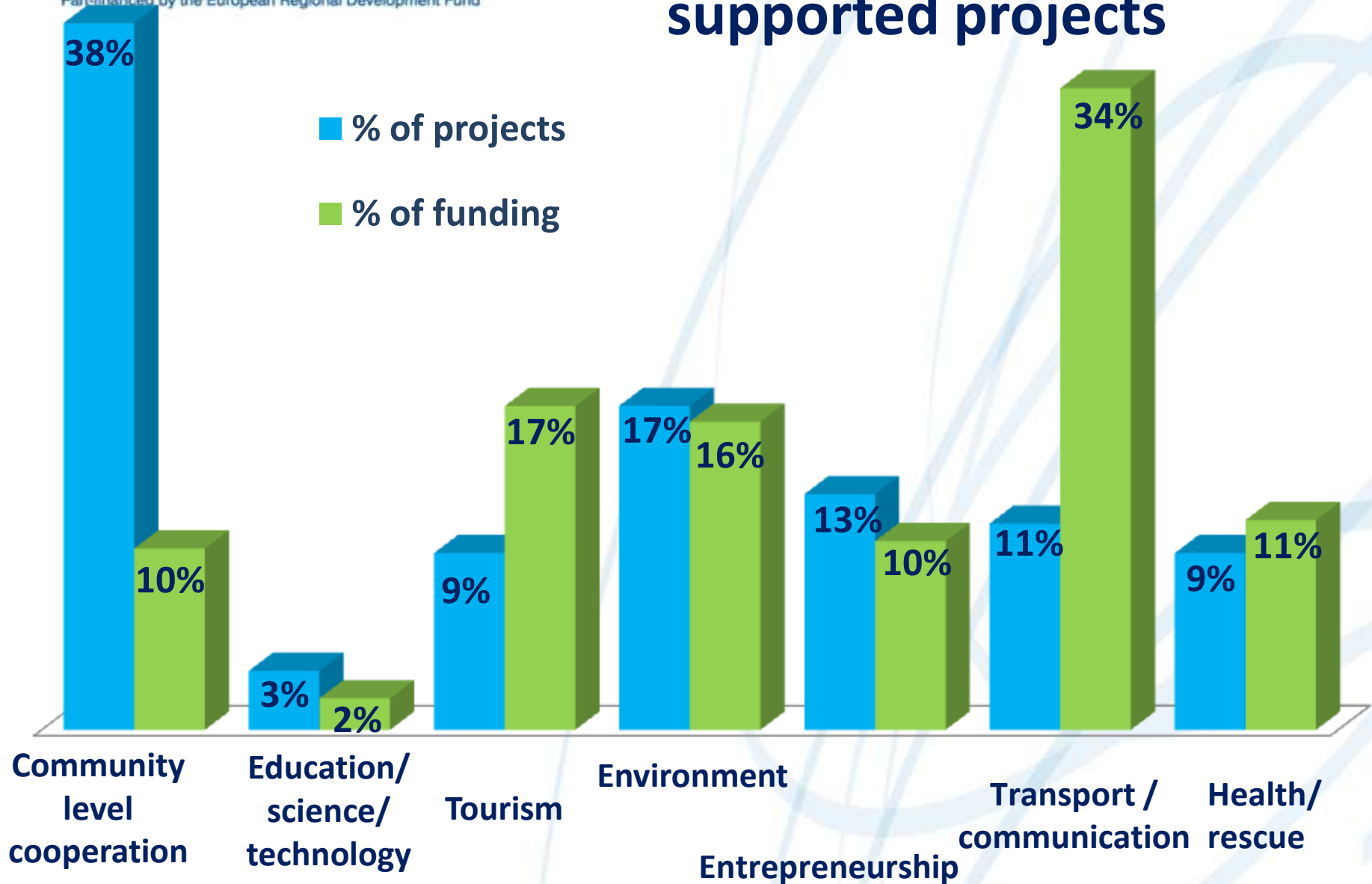
Number of submitted projects - 236



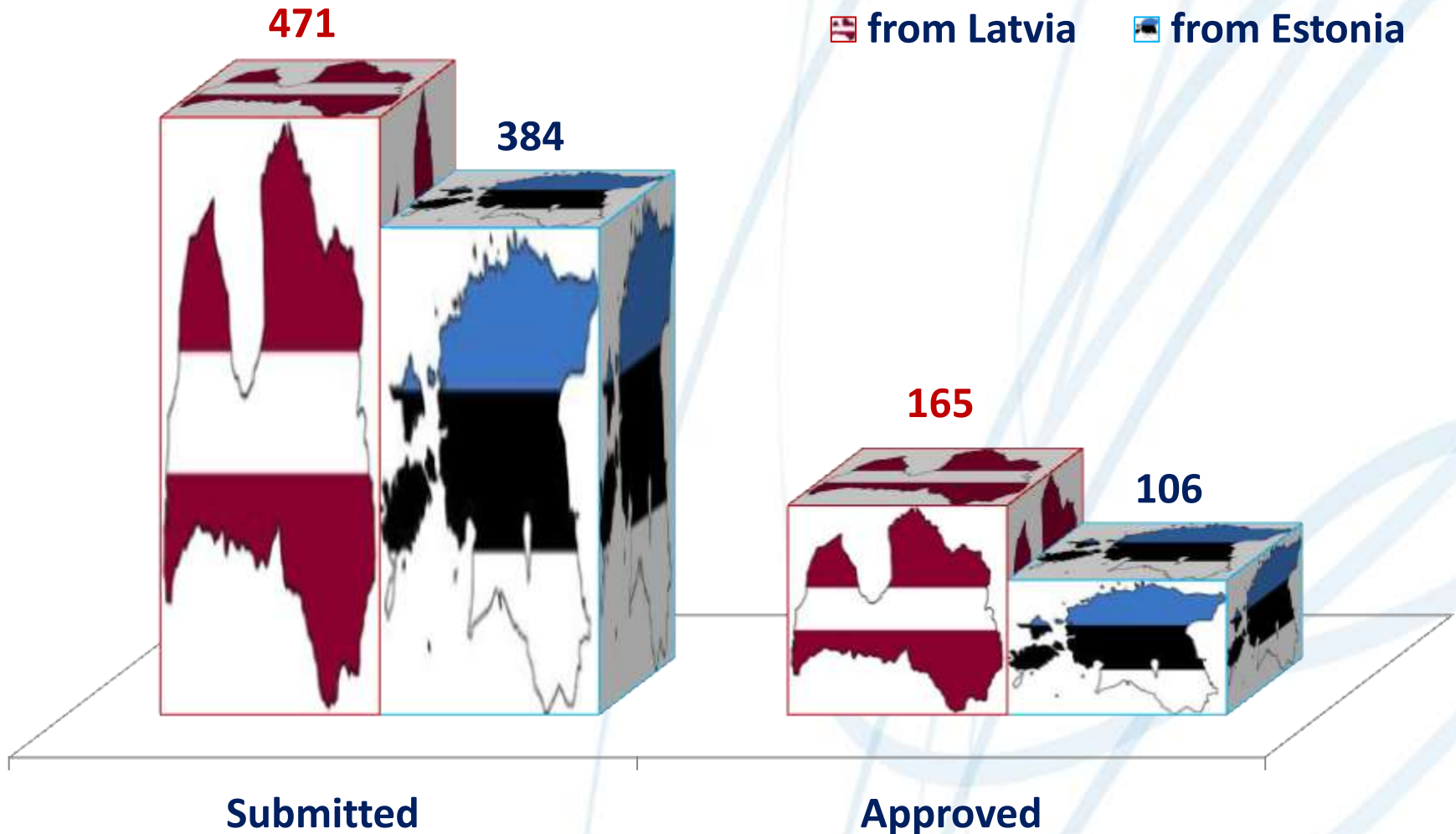
Thematic fields of the submitted projects



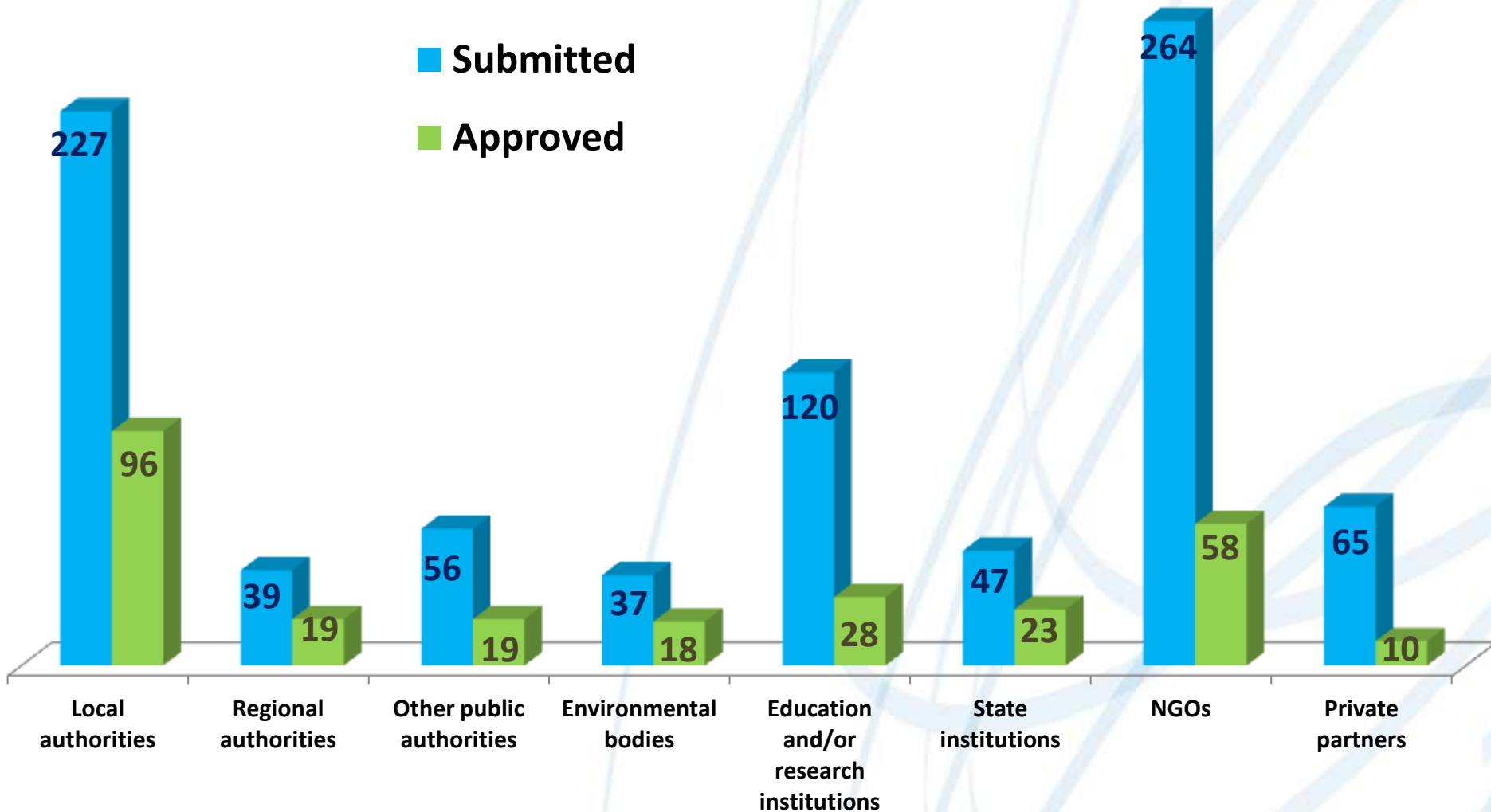
Thematic fields of the supported projects



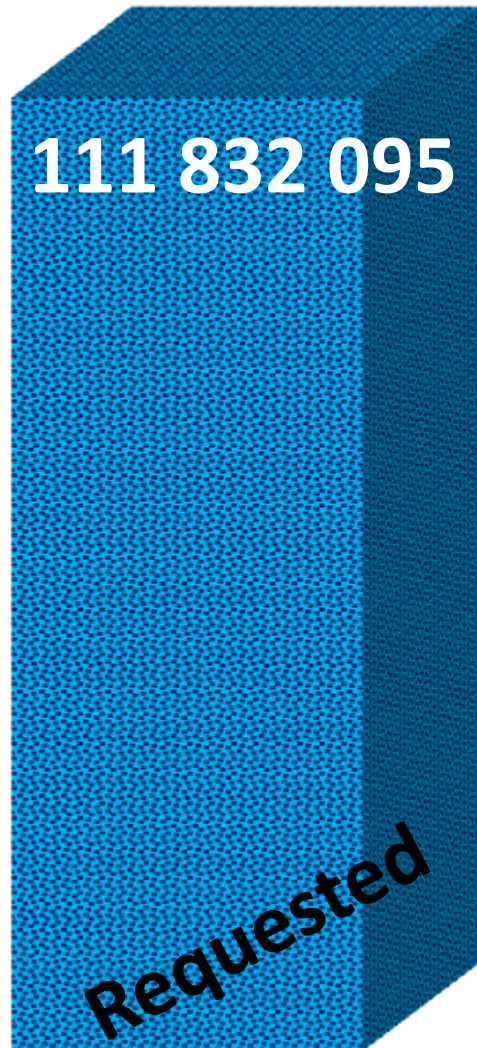
Geographical coverage of the partners by countries



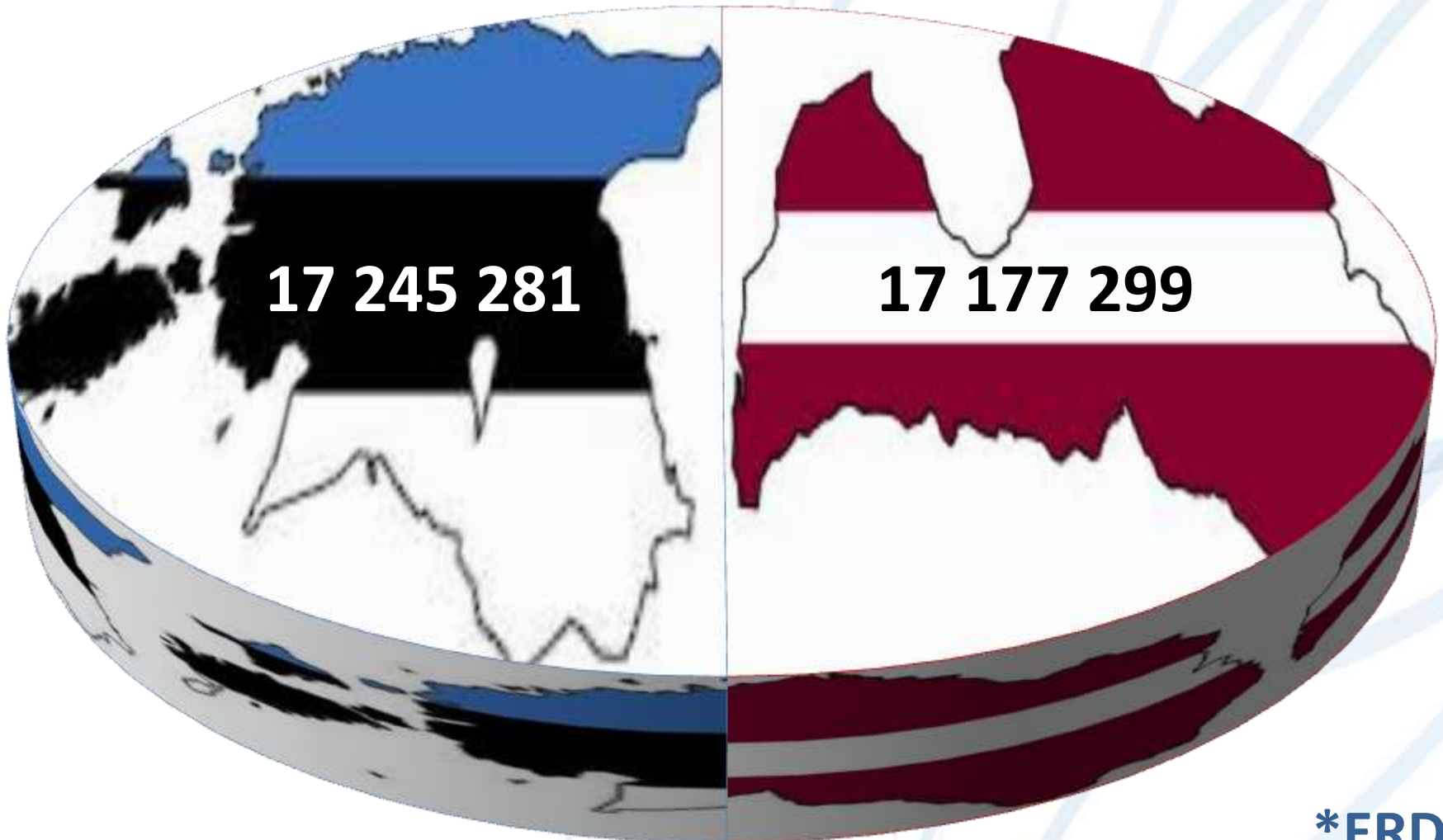
Coverage of the partners by the type of organizations



ERDF (in EUR)

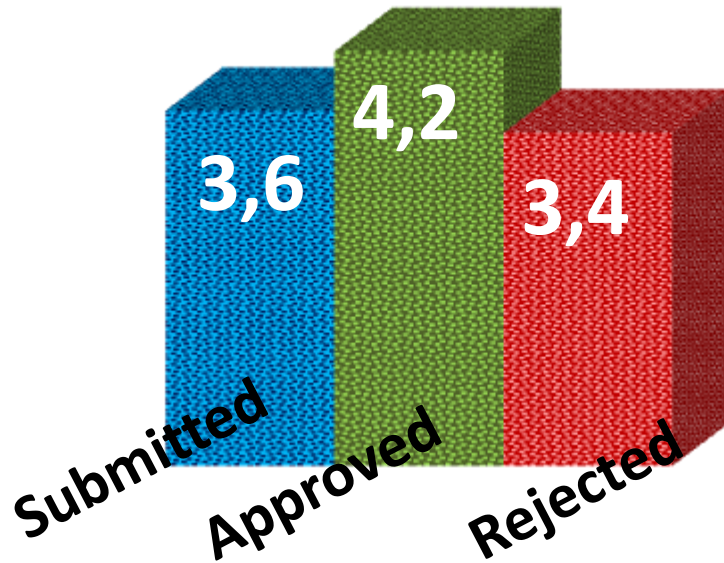


Approved funding* division by countries

Preparations for Estonia - Latvia Programme 2014 - 2020



The decision to start preparing the new Estonia - Latvia Programme was taken by the Member States on 13 February 2012. It was the first meeting where the issues regarding the preparation of the programme were discussed between the Estonian Ministry of the Interior and Ministry of Environmental Protection and Regional Development of the Republic of Latvia. The Managing Authority of Estonia - Latvia Programme 2007 - 2013 has established a Joint Programming Committee for the preparation of the next Estonia - Latvia Programme 2014 - 2020.

Since last year, the Joint Programming Committee has mapped the main challenges, opportunities and cooperation possibilities for the regions and organisations in the programme area.

In order to discuss future intentions and interests, five thematic stakeholder's seminars have been held. Upon this information the Joint Programming Committee has identified the four thematic objectives that will be anchoring the new programme in 2014-2020:

Enhancing the competitiveness of small and medium-sized enterprises (*SME development*);

Protecting the environment and promoting resource efficiency (*Environment*);
